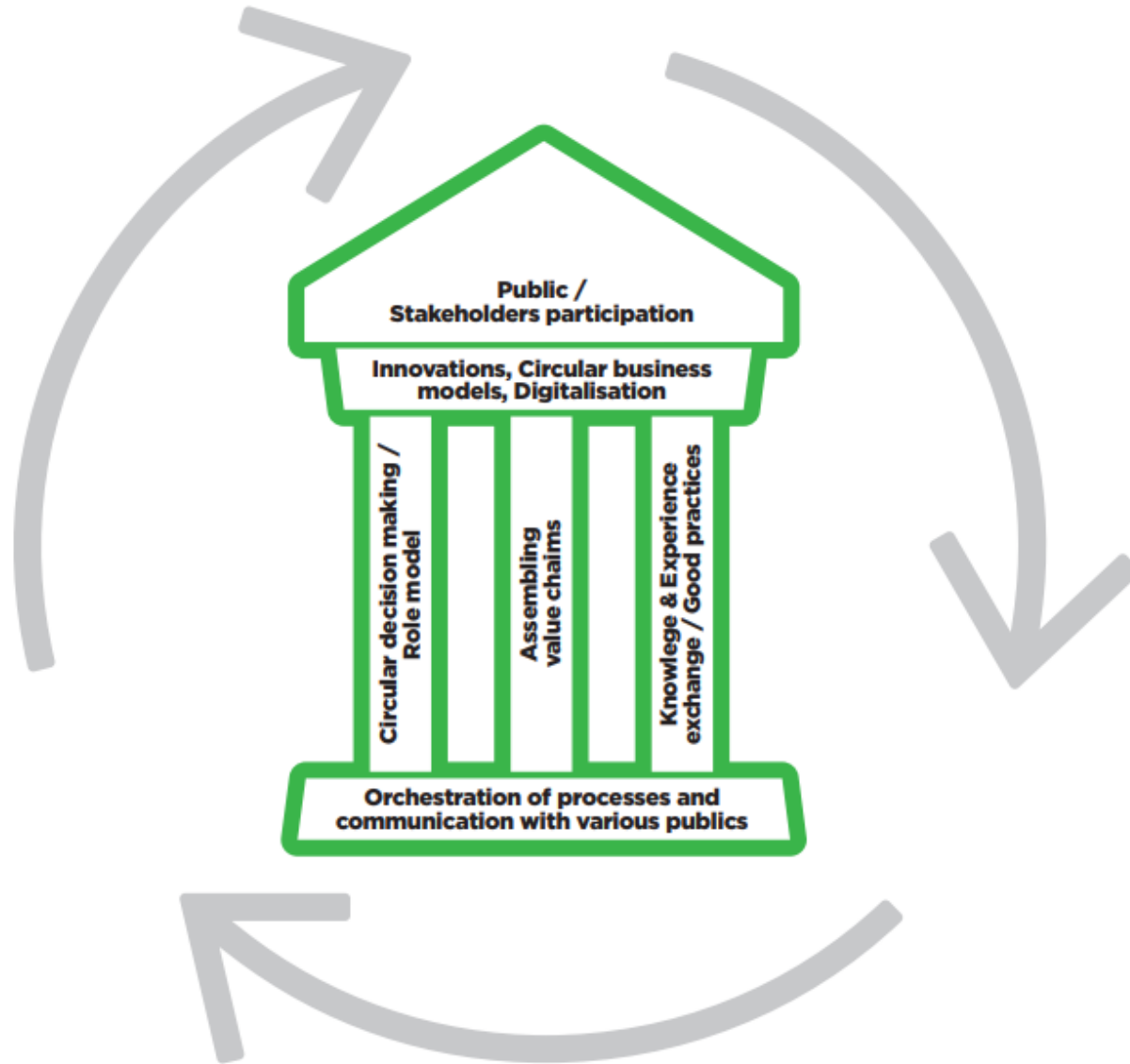

Green decision code for the City administration employees (10 principles of CE, Guidebook)

Circular challenges:

- cycling (45 employees, 8,000 km)
- reuse of goods (3 exchange markets)
- circular office & home
- exchange food surpluses

Public/stakeholders participation

Cities are very closely connected with citizens. Ljubljana's citizens expectations are rising after EGC 2016. City is the first in line to feel the pressure for changes.

Cities more ambitious as national level. Setting up living labs, introducing pilot projects, testing innovative solutions ... that are not foreseen/enabled in the legislation.

Cities play a very important role in transition to circular economy.

Revision of Environmental Law:

PLUS:

- Circular economy one of the fundamental principles.
- Introduction of EPR.

MINUS:

- Include cities in the beginning of the revision process. Look at the whole value chain.
- Implementation of experimental arrangements (pilot projects).
- Implementation of regular monitoring/exchange of knowledge on operational level.
